## Meeting

The Skype Call started at 2.15 p.m.

All the partners agreed to reverse the first 2 points of the agenda because at the very beginning we were missing 2 members. About Communication Laura Faveto for Trionfo Ligure informed the partners that the Facebook and Instagram pages have been opened and she asked the PPS to promote them all. Laura Faveto also asked to give suggestions if the PPS have some in matter of photos, videos and other things to put in the social media pages. Laura Faveto also remembered Francesco Ferrari to send the description of EFA for the website.

Then we passed at the second point of the agenda, the IO, and Beata Mintus, for Collegium Balticum, said that they received all the first surveys they sent; for the second survey they received only the one from Trionfo Ligure, they are waiting on the others. She asked for an improvement on the second template by sending photos and videos that could identify the activities we do. For the end of the WP1 and the beginning of WP2, Beata suggested to do a technical meeting with the PPS that deal with athletics (Trionfo Ligure, IZGEM, IIT) to give the project the right direction. She informed us that they are doing the summaries of the 1st survey. She was also speculating that the end of the IO1 should be by the end of August, so that we will be on time. Beata remembered all the PPS to send her the 2nd survey and to give her all the feedback we could have.

Then we passed on the third point. Because of the COVID situation we have to postpone the meeting in Poland, so Laura Faveto proposed a Skype Call at the end of June or the beginning of July to end the WP1 and start the WP2 and be all on board with the progress made. The proposition was also to do the meeting in Poland in September; Trionfo Ligure will ask the authorization to the European Commission. Francesco Ferrari for EFA suggested that during the next Skype Call we will update each other on each county rules about moving, considering the COVID emergency, so that we can eventually change the plans for the meeting in September; the PPS agreed. We decided to do the next Skype Call on the 6<sup>th</sup> of July 2020 at 2p.m. Beata Mintus proposed to do in the same day the technical one with Trionfo Ligure, IZGEM and IIT; the PPS agreed.

Then we passed to the 4<sup>th</sup> point, and Laura Faveto asked Francesco Ferrari about the first event that should have been organized by EFA in Genoa in June. We agreed to postpone it, and Francesco Ferrari proposed to do it in September so that we can have a clear view of the COVID emergency and the organization could be better structured; the PPS all agreed. Trionfo Ligure will ask the authorization to the Commission.

Laura Faveto did a little sum up of everything that was said during this meeting to be sure that everything was clear to everyone.

Enis Ozdemir asked if there will be a written sum up of the meeting, Laura Faveto told him that it will be surely sent to them.

Considering that there were no more questions or issues, after the group photo, we ended the Skype call at 3 p.m.

#### Meeting

The Skype Call started at 2.00 p.m.

All the partners were present. Annalisa Cevasco for Trionfo Ligure asks Beata Mintus (CB) to update the partnership on the state of the WP1 and on how we can proceed on the WP2. Beata Mintus thanked all the partners for the feedback and the suggestions they gave on the 2 surveys she sent to complete. She also said that we are in time with our planning, and that they have almost finished the first part; she will send it to us by email, and we can translate it in our language. Beata Mintus also said that we will do a specific SkypeCall after this one to do a specific work with the partners that are sport associations (TL, IIT, IZGEM), so that we can give the project the right direction for the WP2 – From Theory to Praxis: we have to connect athletics and street sport/education. Annalisa Cevasco asked Francesco Ferrari (EFA) his opinion and he said we are in a good place with the project, and he also suggested that all partners give their suggestions about youth general conditions, not just the sport association, because we consider also the educational and inclusive aspects. Beata Mintus agreed, but specified that to prepare the WP2 in the best way possible it's important to be precise on sport: the practical side of it.





Then we passed at the next points on the agenda about the Meeting in Poland and the Event in Genoa. Annalisa Cevasco asked Beata Mintus when it could be a good period for us to go in Poland for the meeting; she suggested the first or the second week of September, and all the partners agreed on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> of September 2020. We agreed also that we will keep in touch about it considering the COVID-19 situation and the possible difficulties we could find in travelling. If it will be impossible, we will do the meeting via Skype. We will keep in touch about it.

Considering that the IO1 will be finished in September, Annalisa Cevasco asked Francesco Ferrari if they thought about a date in which we can do the event. He asked Trionfo Ligure when if it's better doing it in September or October, considering that we would like to invite schools and other sport associations to this event of presentation of the project. We agreed that October is the best solution, but we have to decide a specific day; we will wait considering the COVID-19 emergency so that we can be sure of what will be possible to do.

Then we passed at the Communication point in which Laura Faveto (Trionfo Ligure) informed the partners that to keep alive and interesting the social media pages, we thought about doing a presentation every week/2 weeks for each partner so that the project can be more visible on the social media. All agreed. Enis Ozdemir (IZGEM) asked about the translation of the website, and Annalisa Cevasco told him that if they want to do it they have to do it by themselves because for the project it has to be in English.

At 2.35 p.m. we finished the general SkypeCall, and we started the **specific one on sports and non-formal education** that was asked from Beata Mintus to have with Trionfo Ligure, IZGEM and IIT. All the partners decided to stay for this one too.

Beata Mintus (CB) told us about the progress and the details to start the WP2. We have to find the main points to adapt athletics to street sports, so not where it is usually practised (Trionfo Ligure and IZGEM) and how to link it to non-formal education (IIT). She asked the opinions of the 3 partners directly involved about this issue. Calin Rus (IIT) suggested to combine the experiences to create the ideal combination. He proposed to send some ideas that combine all the specific aspects of the project to create a template: sport and target group, so that also the other partners could contribute if they have some ideas. We agreed and Beata Mintus gave us the deadline of the 17<sup>th</sup> of July to send it to her. Annalisa Cevasco said that Trionfo Ligure can do the same with the sport aspects, considering key points and examples with young people. The main goal is to find a way to improve the methodology to include sport and street education. Enis Ozdemir asked Beata Mintus to specify better what she needs and then he said he can do something similar to TL and IIT with a focus on sport considering they do something already in their association.

Beata Mintus was very happy with this idea and she said that these templates will be used to start the WP2. Annalisa Cevasco asked Yannis if he can give us some inputs as municipality on the development of this points from their point of view. Beata Mintus remembered that we need to stay focused on how to bring the concepts from theory to praxis; with our ideas we will develop the contents more or less at the end of July, so that in August we will have the contents for the WP2.

The partners agreed on doing another SkypeCall on the last week of July to talk about the ideas. We will keep in touch about them.

# Meeting

The Skype Call started at 2.00 p.m.

The partners from Cyprus and Romania were not present. Laura Faveto from Trionfo Lifure started the meeting with saying that for the financial aspects we will do a specific Call with Mariangela Bastone from EFA that is the person responsible of these aspects. Mariangela Bastone sent the links to all the documents and a Doodle to program the Skype Call in the next week.

Then Beata Mintus from Collugium Balticum says that they are working on the draft of the WP2 then we will be able to do the translation. She also informs us that they will have a new responsible, that is Natalia Burdzy present today, for our project because of some internal rearrangements, and she will send us all the information to contact her.

Then we started talking about the WP3 with EFA that is the partner responsible for this part of the project. Francesco Ferrari from EFA starts with saying that the situation is crazy in Europe and we have to try to use these months to evolve the theoretical contents. Then he says that IO2 is about the training of trainers of street athletics. We have 2 aspects: what we need for the activities and the skills and tools for trainers. The WP3 is about preparing the target skills and define what skills are needed by everyone in the partnership. An useful thing will be to mix all the information we collected in the IO1 to transform them in practical. We can think about digital lessons that can be used by the Associations that have to do the experimentation. All the Pps can contribute to these aspects. Francesco Ferrari add that we have to create the lessons in this period in which we are waiting for the experimentation; we have to work on 3





levels: skills output of the trainers, filling the contents of the lessons and methodologies to engage young people on the street to do these activities. We have to mix our practices to create the procedure; the experimentation is a test to verify and modify the procedures for the final guidelines.

Francesco Ferrari then give a timeline for these tasks: WP3 from Oct/Nov to Gen/Feb; in Nov/Dec we create the guidelines. He also says that we need to find a way to disseminate the contents: video, PDF... maybe a Youtube channel can be useful, and he asks Beata Mintus if they as a University have some platform or similar tools we can use; she answers that she will check.

Then Mario Bozzo Costa from EFA starts his part on WP3. He informs us on the next immediate steps: elaboration of learning outcomes, work on module we need to prepare, training. An important point is about the competences we need in trainers: put together different profiles: trainers with educational skills. He says that he will split the informations needed in 3 points: basics, entering, outcomes. EFA will send a module to complete to each partner.

Then Mario Bozzo Costa adds that basic and transversal competences are about athletics, street education and integration, rules and regulation on the streets. After the first module we need to build the training and so it's important to understand how to build it, what it is possible to do in presence or online and we can produce material to share.

Then Mario Bozzo Costa asks the partners opinions on what we discussed. Enis Ozdemir from IZGEM sais that a creation of a tutorial on different topics could be good, for examples first aid tutorial, good use of tools... Then Beata Mintus from Collegium Balticum says that maybe we can start on general topic on what we want so that we can extend it. So it's important to use the knowledge of all the Pps and we also need to think about what we need considering all our realities.

Mario Bozzo Costa asks about a summary of the competences founded in the IO1 so that they can have a feedback to start from.

EFA will prepare a first general module and Mario Bozzo Costa will send it to us to complete in the next week

Considering there were no more issue we ended the Call at 3.05 P.m.

## Meeting

The Skype Call started at 10.00 a.m.

The partners from Cyprus and Turkey were not present. Annalisa Cevasco from Trionfo Ligure starts saying that she hopes that this Skype Call on the financial aspects will be useful to all the Pps to clarify all the aspects of the financing regarding our project. Then she let Mariangela Bastone from EFA start with her intervention and presentation. We all agreed to record the meeting so that it can remain into the archives so that we will have it at our disposal in the future.

Mariangela Bastone started with her presentation: there are 2 categories of contribution, the Unit Contribution and the Actual Costs. All the Pps have the Unit Costs on the topics of the project they are directly involved in. All the costs have to be in the period of the project (from 01/01/2020 to 30/06/2021).

Mariangela Bastone starts to analyse all the categories of the costs: the first is **Project Management and Implementation (PMI)**. It is based on the number of months. There is no need to present some kind of documentation for this category, but there is need of proof that all the activities will be implemented. The second one is the **Transnational Project Meeting (TPM)**: it's based on the number of people that are travelling according to the distance band for the travel. There is need to prove the presence of the people with the attendance lists and all the travel documentations. Slovenia and Romania asked about the invoices of the meals because they have an income for each day due to their regulation. Mariangela Bastone says that they need to write a note in which it's specified this thing because everyone needs to follow their internal rules. She also asked to try to collect all the documentation now so that we can have everything ready for all the controls by the Agency there will possibly be in the next years (til 5 years after the end of the project). If there is a need to change the place of departure the Pps need to





inform us so that it can be specified and calculated in the right amount in the costs. All the travellers need to be linked to the organization. The third category is the **Intellectual Output (IO)**. It needs to be reported by the timesheets and the contracts of the people working on it considering the days they have worked on the IO. This costs can't be put into the meeting days if the IO aren't in the Agenda of the meeting and so there is no working activity related to them in the meeting. The fourth category is the **Multiplier Events (ME).** It's calculated with the number of participants and the unit applicable to every participants. The documentation needed is the participant list, the agenda and every other document considered necessary.


Then Mariangela Bastone says that it was asked to the Agency about the costs for the online meetings and event and they answered that these costs are not included in the budget. But we can transfer budget from the meetings to the exceptional costs if there are some purchasing needed (ex. Equipment for online activities) but we need to ask to the Agency specifying everything and we need their approval.

After that she gave us the general scheme of the Reports that are needed:

First Progress Report: 01/01/2020 - 30/09/2020, deadline 31/10/2020
First Interim Report: 01/10/2020 - 31/03/2021, deadline 15/04/2021
Second Progress Report: 01/04/2021 - 31/12/2021, deadline 15/01/2022
Second Interim Report: 01/01/2022 - 30/06/2022, deadline 15/07/2022

All the reports are needed in English, and it is also needed an extract of the most relevant parts of the contract in English. All the expenses must be in Euros; there are the conversion details on the link Mariangela Bastone gave during the meeting and that are on her presentation that she will put on the common Drive of the project.

Laura Faveto from Trionfo Ligure tells Beata Mintus that we will send their new responsible for the project all the documentation and information needed so that she can be on board. Considering there were no more issues we closed the Skype Call at 10.50 a.m.

### Meeting

The Skype Call started at 2.00 p.m.

Only one partner (EFA) wasn't present. Annalisa Cevasco from Trionfo Ligure asks to the Partners how the Covid-19 emergency is evolving in each country. Yannis Konnaris from the Municipality of Pegeia starts by saying that in Cyprus is worse than before, in fact they have lockdown in the country and they are all in smartworking. He doesn't think the situation will improve in January; he hypothesize a lockdown situation even in January. Then Calin Rus from IIT (Romania) says that in his country the situation is the same as before, it's very difficult to do any kind of activities, and the ones possible are just outdoor activities. Even the Schools are closed. And in his opinion January is a not knowing situation. Then Natalia Burdzy from Collegium Balticum says that in Poland all the activities are online at the moment, but they hope that January will be better. After that Tjasa Kozjan from DRPDNM says that in Slovenia the situation is the worst since the beginning of the pandemic. It's not possible to do activities in person, everything is online and it's not so simple. And everything is more complicated due to some political issues that are present in the country at the moment. Then Enis Ozdemir from Izmir Youth Centres Sports Club talked about Turkey in which activities in person are not possible, everything is online and on weekend they are in lockdown. Then Ruxandra Stanica from GESEME says that in Spain the situation is





different from one Region to the other, and even the contagion in different between the regions. In her Region the schools are closed and they are in partial lockdown. She hypothesizes that maybe in 4-5 ,months it could be better due to the vaccine. After that Annalisa Cevasco talks about the situation in Italy: the Regions are divided with colours depending on their contagion situation. There are night lockdowns. It is possible to do outdoor activities, for example outdoor training.

Then Annalisa Cevasco starts analysing what it is possible to do in the next months: she proposes to change the event to an online one, a webinar maybe divided in two parts: one in English with the participation of all the Pps, and the other in which each partner can do a brief thing in their country and in their language. The Pps like the idea, so Annalisa Cevasco proposes January 2021 as a possible period, and she adds that maybe in Genoa it will be possible to try to do something in person in social distancing. She asks to the Pps to send any ideas to do the Meeting.

Ruxandra Stanica from GESEME tells the Pps that in another program there is an addendum covid oriented to not lose the budget and she will send the draft to Annalisa Cevasco so that we can understand better and verify if it is possible to have something similar also for our project.

Then about the Meeting 3 in Cyprus the Pps agreed on the possibility to postpone it or maybe to find a solution to do it online.

Then Annalisa Cevasco asks Natalia Burdzy from Collegium Balticum about the WP2 Report. Natalia Burdzy says that all the translation are done. The Report is the same in English and in every language. She will send it to us on the 11<sup>th</sup> of December. Annalisa Cevasco asks about the dissemination of the IO1, and Natalia Burdzy says that they have a publishing house at the University that will publish every version online, and then there will be an article with a link to the Report. Maybe also a thing on the Youtube channel to which every partner can register.

After that Annalisa Cevasco reminds Calin Rus to send EFA the survey about the WP3 so that they can have everything to put together.

Annalisa Cevasco asks to do another Skype Call in the following week to discuss only about WP3 and in which EFA will be present to discuss the next steps about it. We will create a doodle to find a suitable date.

### Meeting

The Skype Call started at 2.00 p.m.

All the partners are present. Annalisa Cevasco from Trionfo Ligure makes some suggestions on the design of the IO1 Report: add a small sum up and some thematic graphic for the presentation of the IO1. She also suggests we can add some photos and a map on the part about the countries involved in the partnership. Natalia Burdzy says they can do the changes and asks the Pps to send her every suggestion they have on the report within the next Monday. She also confirmed the possibility of the pubblication for the dissemination of the report. She also thinks it will be good to do a video for promotion.

Then we passed to the second point of the Agenda: the Event in Genoa. We imagined to plan it as a webinar in January (probably on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of January 2021) divided in two parts: the first one more general in English with the participation of all the Pps, and a second one that can be done in each country in their own language so that the local associations are able to participate and to be involved in a more active way. Francesco Ferrari adds that they will send a draft of the Agenda and they will collect all the suggestions. The association that could be involved in each country are sports ones and non-formal





education ones. He also hypothesizes 5 to 10 minutes for each partner to present themselves and their activities. Considering we will do it online it will be max 2 hours. We will collect all the contribution and we will try to have a lot of Track&Field associations involved in the event. The main objective of the Event is to describe the results of the IO1 and the next steps of the project.

Then we passed at the 3<sup>rd</sup> point of the Agenda. Mario Bozzo Costa from EFA asks Calin Rus about their template on the WP3, and he says that he will send it in the afternoon. Then Mario Bozzo Costa does a summary of the data: he has a lot of data on the sport and soft competences parts; the results are a lot. He proposes to plan an online session to discuss only about the WP3 themes. He proposes to create a tutorial to create the modules for the trainings. He asks suggestion to all the Pps and he says that he will put everything he worked on on the Google Drive so that everyone can look at it and send him suggestions and contributions. He hypothesize that the planning of the training will end in February. Mario Bozzo Costa also says that he will create a doodle to plan the session, and he will wait on the contributions from all the Pps. He also need clearance on the difference between trainers and street educators.

Then we went to the 3<sup>rd</sup> point of the Agenda: Meeting 3 in Cyprus. Annalisa Cevasco suggests that it can be connected to the WP3: we can use it as a webinar in more sections in which we can have some training moments and some discussion. She adds that we need to find a possible platform to do it on.

Francesco Ferrari from EFA says we will keep updated on it so that we can keep everything in order.

After that we pass to the next point on the Agenda Annalisa Cevasco says that we will send an e-mail to the Agency to ask confirmation about our planning for the next activities.

Then about the 5<sup>th</sup> point Annalisa Cevasco says that in our program we don't have an addendum covid oriented, so we can't make any changes on our plans, but maybe we can transfer some money to buy for example technical supports for the online activities.

After that Enis Ozdemir from Izmir Youth Centres Sports Club suggests to ask the Agency about the possibility of postponing all the meetings in a shorter period of time, maybe in summer. Annalisa Cevasco says that we wil try to ask and we will be back to them with what they tell us.

Then Annalisa Cevasco does a little sum up of everything and we close the Skype Call at 2.45 p.m.

We all agreed, and Mario Bozzo Costa added that stimulation of the participants is important before reflection, because it is important to give the concepts and the instruments to evolve.


From these modules we can construct the training, and after that we can do a call to confront our idea on it. We can relate to the general template to put together everything. Mario Bozzo Costa asked us to

The Skype Call started at 3 p.m. CET

Laura Faveto from Trionfo Ligure asked about the situation in each Country considering the evolution of COVID-19. Calin Rus from IIT offered to do the technological aspects that don't have a partner responsible on the tab. Mario Bozzo Costa then gave the division of the competencies and he also prepared and exposed to the pps 2 questionaires: an entering one and a ending one. The entering one have to be completed by the pps, the other one by the participants at the course. He reminded again that te experimentation has to begin at least at the beginning of November.

Calin Rus asked if it is possible to involve other sports or if it's mandatory to consider just athletics; Laura Faveto answers that it is possible to do it and it is also interesting considering that the general idea is to create a model that can be used also by other sports.

Then Laura Faveto informed the pps that the interim report went well and that the Agency send us the next tranche of the money, so in the next weeks we will send to the pps their budget. She also said that we are working on the new timeline with Mariangela Bastone from EFA so that it will be ready for the Meeting in Cyprus.

The goal is to reach at least 20 interviews.

Annalisa Cevasco also asked all the pps to think about how they think the guidelines can be created so that we can put together all the ideas and do a complete work.


